RE: Qualification of Canadian Boilermakers

Dear Colleagues,

In an effort to maintain fair and equitable referral of workers in the Boilermaker industry, the National Joint Rules and Standards Committee has determined the following concerning Canadian Boilermakers:

- 1) The Canadian Boilermaker Apprenticeship Program is the equivalent of an apprenticeship program approved by the United States Bureau of Apprenticeship Training, and
- 2) Graduates of the Canadian Boilermaker Apprenticeship Program meet the same Uniform Referral Standards and Joint Referral Rules qualifications of graduates of an apprenticeship program approved by the United States Bureau of Apprenticeship Training, and
- 3) Canadian Boilermakers that have satisfactorily completed and graduated from the Canadian National Apprenticeship Program shall be deemed as a Qualified Construction Boilermaker as defined in Article 6.1.1 (3) of the Uniform Referral Standards and Joint Referral Rules.
- 4) The Canadian Boilermaker Master Rigger Course will be considered the equivalent of the MOST Rigger Training Course, and
- 5) Those Boilermakers who have successfully completed all modules of the Canadian Master Rigger Course meet the Uniform Referral Standards and Joint Referral Rules qualifications of those Boilermakers that have successfully completed all modules of the MOST Rigger Training Course.

You are reminded of the posting requirements as set forth in Articles 2.3 and 8.4 of these Rules. Please post this notice on the Local Lodge bulletin board, website, job site location and/or facility where the Uniform Referral Standards and Joint Referral Rules are displayed.
